Getting to Know Your Data

Effective planning practices, and our accreditation standards, emphasize using data when making planning decisions. When sitting down to do program review, you might feel a sense of dread or overwhelm when faced with the wide variety of data sources and many questions might come to mind: What do I do with the data? Can I trust the data? How do I interpret the data?

The Office of Research, Planning and Grants maintains a website which provides a smorgasbord of data sources and information that can be useful for program review and to support campus decision-making, planning, and policy formation. In addition to preparing statistical content and reports for Accreditation, Campus Climate Surveys, Fast Facts, Faculty Hiring Process, IPEDS, Program Review, Strategic Planning, SLOs, and Title V, the research office performs many additional ad hoc

Highlights of the New Snapshot:

- Online Interface with checkboxes and dropdown menus (No WORD files)
- Emphasis on creating SMART goals
- Stronger connections between strategic planning goals, program goals, data, and resource requests.
- Limits on the number of goals and number of resource requests
- Character limits in text fields
- Improved efficiency in managing data for budget development and prioritization
- Expected two-three year stopgap as we discuss a permanent solution
