Register for Summer Classes

<u>Class Registration</u> for Summer 2015 starts on May 4. Your <u>Registration Appointment</u> is the time & date that you can start registering for classes & can be found on https://webadvisor.swccd.edu. You should register for classes as soon as possible because classes fill up quickly. WebAdvisor registration is available daily from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight. **The Summer class schedule is available at** www.swccd.edu

Be Aware of Waitlist Procedures

- ♦ Students on waitlist will be notified via email when an open seat becomes available.
- ♦ Students will then have <u>3 calendar days</u> to register in the open seat reserved for them. If the student does not register within the 3-day period, the student will be removed from the waitlist.
- ♦ Once the student enrolls, the student MUST <u>pay his or her balance within 5 days</u> to avoid being dropped from all of his or her classes.

Financial Aid

The BOGFW application is now available on the SWC webpage at www.swccd.edu/financialaid.

This application covers tuition for the 2015-2016 academic year, <u>Summer 2015</u>, <u>Fall 2015 & Spring 2016</u>. You can still apply/renew FAFSA applications. To avoid delays on your award, you MUST <u>check your email and submit any requested paperwork</u> to the financial aid department, otherwise your file will not be processed.

Please arrive on time because late arrives will be rescheduled.



Attorney's Corner



Be Smart, Don't Drink & Drive!!!

DUI stands for "Driving Under the Influence of alcohol, drugs, and or certain medications."

A DUI is a serious offense and can lead to lifelong consequences. A <u>conviction</u> means that you are found guilty of a crime.

For starters, if you are convicted of a simple DUI, the best case scenario is that it will cost a lot of money and waste a lot of your time.

Here are some of the standard/mandatory consequences:

- ◆ Court Fines: Approximately \$1,800
- ♦ Mandatory 30-Day Driver License Suspension
- Mandatory "3-Month" 1st Conviction DUI Program which costs \$600
- ◆ Attorney Fees: May cost up to \$7,000
- ♦ Bail: Starting at \$250.

Some of The Possible Immigration Consequences if you are not a U.S. Citizen:

- If convicted of DUI for driving under the influence of DRUGS, you are in danger of losing your privilege to apply for citizenship and deportation.
- If convicted of felony DUI (e.g. a DUI with injuries), then you are in danger of being deported.

Please remember this & think twice before driving while under the influence of anything.
