The WFR certification is the industry standard for guides, SAR teams, and outdoor recreationalists.

Certification

All students who successfully complete the WFR course will be eligible for a WFR certification card, an Anaphylaxis certification card and a BLS-CPR certification card from **Wilderness Medical Associates**. These certifications remain valid for three years.
