INSURANCE

Reference: Education Code Sections 70902; 72502; 72506; 81601, et seg.;

Government Code 6500

The Superintendent/President shall be responsible to secure insurance for the College District as required by law, which shall include but is not limited to the liabilities described in Education Code Section 72506 as follows:

- Liability for damages for death, injury to persons, or damage or loss of property;
- Personal liability of the members of the Governing Board and the officers and employees of the College District for damages for death, injury to a person, or damage or loss of property caused by the negligent act or omission of the member, officer or employee when acting within the scope of his or her office or employment. The Superintendent/President may authorize coverage for persons who perform volunteer services for the College District.
- Worker's Compensation insurance.

Insurance also shall include College District real and personal property insurance, fire insurance and insurance against other perils.

The College District may join in a joint powers agreement pursuant to Education Code Section 81603 for the purposes described in this policy.

A fund shall be maintained to receive transfers from the general fund for payments on deductible types of insurance policies, losses or payments arising from self-insurance programs, or noninsured losses. The balance available for the payment of deductibles after payment of budgeted current expenses shall not be less than \$100,000.
