## Eligifility Requirements:

- Must enroll in a CWEE course (290) within the first three weeks of the semester (first week for Summer)
- Must have declared a major and perform internship/work experience hours in an area directly related to major.


## Student Responsitilities:

- Meet with instructor individually to discuss internship needs and/or placement.
- Students must secure a paid/unpaid internship or employment in their major by the FIFTH class meeting or risk being dropped from class.
- All students must complete the minimum hours required in order to receive a passing grade.
- Students are required to attend weekly or hybrid CWEE lecture class meeting and complete assignments during the semester to receive a passing grade.
- Notify instructor if they would like a reduction in units (during refund period) as all students are automatically enrolled with 4 units.


## Required Documentation:

1. Cooperative Work Experience Education (CWEE) - Agreement (white)
2. Information and Visitation Form (Blue)
3. CWEE Time Card (pink)

- Must have all forms completed and signed.
- Failure to complete forms will result in an incomplete grade.
- Before submitting documents, print a copy for your records.
- Return all forms to instructor.

Students may earn up to (4) units per semester/session and a maximum of sixteen units while attending SWC. The minimum hours must be completed during the semester or students will not earn a passing grade.
