LIBRARY AND LEARNING SUPPORT SERVICES

Reference: Education Code Section 78100;

Civil Code Section 1798.90; ACCJC Accreditation Standard II

The Southwestern Community College District shall have library and learning support services that are an integral part of the institution's educational program and will comply with the requirements of the Reader Privacy Act.

It is the policy of the College District to permit all members of the community to visit and to use the College District library facilities at any time the facilities are open. Adults (18 years of age or older) who reside in San Diego County may apply for courtesy borrowing privileges from the College District library. Additionally, high school students who are identified as members of an approved partnership program (such as the California Scholarship Federation or International Baccalaureate) at schools within the College District may apply for borrowing privileges. There is no fee for this services.

Applications must have the following forms of identifications:

- Regular Community Borrowers: Government-issued photo ID with name, age, and address
- High School Members: Current semester school ID card and approval from program affiliate.

Both community borrowers and high school members' privileges are subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. Check-out is limited to a maximum of five (5) items.
- 2. Borrowers are not eligible for interlibrary loans service.
- 3. All other library guidelines and Circulation policies apply.
