

WEAPONS ON CAMPUS

References: Penal Code Sections 626.9 and 626.10

Firearms, knives, explosives or other dangerous objects, including, but not limited to, any facsimile firearm, knife or explosive, are prohibited on any College District property, campus or at any College District higher education center, or in any facility of the College District.

Activities involving firearms or other weapons or facsimiles conducted under the direction of appropriate College District staff or as authorized by an official law enforcement agency shall be reported to the Chief of Police or designee before taking place.

Any person who believes that he/she may properly possess a firearm, facsimile or other weapon on any campus or facility of the College District must promptly notify the Chief of Police or designee in a timely manner.

It is prohibited to possess any dirk, dagger, ice pick, or knife having a fixed blade longer than 2 1/2 inches upon the grounds of any College District property, campus or at any College District higher education center, unless the person is authorized to possess such a weapon in the course of his/her employment, or is a duly appointed peace officer who is engaged in the performance of his/her duties, is prohibited on any College District campus or at any College District education center, or in any facility of the College District.
