STIPEND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: **ASKED** Must be enrolled in a 290 course or an approved course equivalent Must have declared (CTE) Major (Career Technical Education) ☐ Must have completed at least two (2) core classes from their CTE major Must **submit a resume** (to be reviewed by instructor, counselor or Student Employment Service Staff) ☐ Must have a comprehensive **Student Education Plan (SEP)** on file ☐ Must submit the Stipend Eligibility Notification form to Student Employment Services ☐ Must **obtain an internship placement** with a verified employer/company/agency How much Stipend will a student receive? □ Eligible students will receive \$660 with the completion of 60 or more internship hours. When will the student receive the stipend? □ Student will receive the first increment (\$330) stipend upon the completion of 30 hours and will be disbursed based on payroll schedule. Student will receive the second increment (\$330) stipend upon the completion of another 30 hours or more and will be disbursed based on payroll schedule. How will the student receive the stipend? STIPEND PROCESSING REQUIREMENTS: First Increment: To be submitted to Student Employment ☐ Must submit a copy of CWEE Agreement with required signatures from Employer and Student Must submit a copy of Pink Timecard to show 30 hours of completed internship hours for the first increment of stipend disbursement Must present original Social Security Card to Student Employment Services (copies are not accepted) Must present **Picture ID**, i.e. California Driver's License, State ID, or valid Passport Second Increment: To be submitted to respective Instructors Must submit Original CWEE Agreement with all 3 signatures: Employer, Student, Instructor Must submit Original Pink Timecard with completed hours Must submit Original Blue Visitation Card Paycheck will be available for pick up at the Cashiers (1st floor Cesar Chavez Bldg.) How many times can a student take the class and receive stipend? > Student can only receive a stipend **ONCE**. > Student can take the class up to 4 (four) times, but receive stipend only once. Availability of stipend is determined on a per term basis.
