Learning Communities

Learning communities such as First Year Experience (FYE), Umoja, Bayan and Puente allow cohorts of students to share some of the same classes. Students participate in special workshops, field trips and activities that help build a connection with their peers, professors and counselors that leads to increased academic success.

Power Study Program (PSP)

Academic tutors are embedded in certain classes to provide students with additional support inside and outside of the classroom. Students who take advantage of meeting with the tutors increase their grades and success in their classes.

Associate Degree for Transfer-ADT (Degree with a Guarantee)

Students who enroll in one of more than 20 majors and complete 60 units in that major are guaranteed admission into a California State University (CSU) campus. The qualifying majors have been fully aligned with bachelor's degree programs in the CSU system.
