Accommodations

The Silver Palms Guest House is located at the base of the beautiful Ou Kaapse Weg mountain pass. Bordering the well-known Silvermine & Cape of Good Hope National Reserves, it's only a 2 minute drive from the world famous Chapmans Peak drive. Visitors enjoy a comfortable, home-away-from-home experience including en-suite bathrooms, DSTV, bar fridge & microwave, as well as tea & coffee facilities.

The Team House is ideally situated at the base of Chapman's Peak on Long Beach in Cape Town. Its 40 minutes from the city centre and about 25 minutes from Cape Point. Wake up to the sound of the sea and fall asleep to the whisper of the wind.
