

Wilderness First Responder (WFR)

If you spend time in the outdoors, you know that medical emergencies could be very difficult to manage in a wilderness context. This course will focus on backcountry medicine as it relates to: Extended patient management and delayed transport, Severe environments, and Limited and improvised equipment. The WFR certification is the industry standard for guides, SAR teams, and outdoor recreationalists.

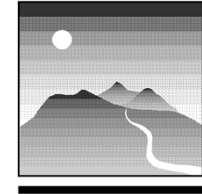
Where: Southwestern College Aquatic Center (The Strand on Coronado Island)

Certification

All students who successfully complete the WFR course will be eligible for a WFR certification card, an Anaphylaxis certification card and a BLS-CPR certification card from **Wilderness Medical Associates**. These certifications remain valid for three years.

No medical experience is needed to attend this class.
