## Area 6 LANGUAGES OTHER THAN ENGLISH (UC Requirement Only)

$\square$ 1. Completion of two years of high school study in the same language with a grade of " C " or better.
$\square$ 2. Satisfactory completion, with $C$ grades or better, of two years of formal schooling at the sixth grade level or higher in an institution where the language of instruction is not English. The appropriate documentation such as a letter from the ministry of education must be presented to the evaluation office to substantiate that the required coursework was completed. High school transcripts are not acceptable unless they clearly state that the two years of instruction were done in the student's native language other than English. Students who cannot provide such documentation should either pass one of the examinations or tests listed below in 3 through 5 , or satisfactorily complete an appropriate language course at Southwestern College, as outlined in 6 below.
$\square$ 3. Satisfactory score, 500 or higher, in the SAT II: Subject Tests in languages other than English. Consult the College Board for exact scores over 500 after May 1995 and requirements before May 1995.
$\square$ 4. Satisfactory score, 3 or higher, in the College Board Advanced Placement Examinations in languages other than English.5. Satisfactory score, 5 or higher, in the International Baccalaureate Higher Level Examinations in language other than English.
