

COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD

Reference: Government Code Section 54952

The Governing Board may establish committees that it determines are necessary to assist the Board in its responsibilities. Any committee established by Governing Board action shall comply with the requirements of the Brown Act and with these policies regarding open meetings. The Charge of the committee shall be determined by the Governing Board at the time the committee is established.

Governing Board committees that are advisory in nature, and are composed solely of less than a quorum of members of the Board, are not required to comply with the Brown Act or with these policies regarding open meetings, unless they are standing committees.

Governing Board committees have no authority or power to act on behalf of the Board. Findings or recommendations shall be reported to the Governing Board for consideration.
