Medical Coding & Insurance

As insurance companies and health care agencies require more highly detailed records of services, the need for medical billing and coding professionals has grown rapidly.

What is Medical Coding?

Medical codes identify specific outpatient-inpatient procedures and services for billing private and public insurance companies.

Medical coders assign specific codes to medical procedures and services.

Medical coders are essential in the health information industry. In fact, without them, the industry would be at a virtual standstill.



Medical coders read medical documentation (i.e. patient charts) then assign the proper code to the completed service or procedure, relying upon their knowledge and classification manuals. Once the proper coding is completed, medical coders key the code into the computer system.
