Paralegal Studies: Bilingual

Paralegals who are fluent in both Spanish and English are in high demand in San Diego County, especially with lawyers practicing in immigration law, family law, personal injury and criminal law. Southwestern College offers a certificate and a degree program to help individuals prepare for employment as bilingual paralegals. The program offers courses in various types of law, as well as in Spanish legal terminology and interpretation/translation courses. This program satisfies the educational requirements for paralegals under California law. A degree is required for those students who do not have a college degree. A certificate is awarded to those students who already have an A.A. or A.S. degree or higher.

The degree and certificate are designed to train students to assist lawyers in private firms, legal departments of companies, or governmental agencies. Upon successful completion of the program requirements, the student will have the ability to apply theories and principles of law, prepare or interpret legal documents, draft pleadings including court forms, prepare for litigation, apply legal ethics, case management techniques, and skills for client interaction, and research the law, including on-line legal research. Competency will be assessed regularly by examinations and projects.
