COMMUNITY USE OF COLLEGE LIBRARY

It is the policy of the Southwestern Community College District to permit all members of the community to visit and use the college library facilities at anytime that they are open. Additionally, adults (18 years of age or older) who reside in San Diego or are current members of the California Scholarship Federation at schools within the district served by Southwestern College may apply for courtesy borrowing privileges from the college library. There is no fee for this service.

Applicants must have one of the following forms of identifications:

- 1. Regular Community Borrowers: ID with name, age and address
- 2. CSF Members: Current semester membership card

Community borrowing privileges are subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. Both adult and CSF community borrowers are limited to a maximum of five (5) items.
- 2. They may not check-out periodicals or reserve materials for home use, but materials may be used in the building.
- 3. Community borrowers are not eligible for interlibrary loans.
